Class 1: Yearlings; colt, filly or geldings

Class 2: 2 year olds; colt filly or geldings

Class 3: 3 year olds; colt, filly or geldings

In-hand Youngstock Championship

1st and 2nd prize winner from classes 1, 2 and 3

Class 4: 4 years and over Stallions

Class 5: 4 years and over Geldings

Class 6: 4 years and over Mares with foal at foot

Class 6a: Best Foal (foal must be at least 3 weeks of age on the day of the show)

Class 7: 4 years and over Mares without foal at foot

(Prize to the Best Veteran, 16 years and over)

Senior Championship:

1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 4,5,6 and 7

Class 8: In-hand pairs

Class 9: Best bred on Exmoor

Class 10: Best bred outside of Exmoor

Class 11: Junior Handler, 14 years and under

Ridden Classes

Class 12: Lead Rein and Junior ridden

Class 13: Novice ridden (Pony not to have won prize money of more than 15 at the time of entry closure. Pony is to be ridden in a snaffle bridle)

Class 14: Open Ridden

Ridden Championship

1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 12,13 and 14

Best rider over the age of 21

Bottle of champagne to be awarded to the best rider over 21 years old. In loving memory of Jackie Ablett and Gill Langdon.

Best rider under 18

The Marion Williams award will be awarded to the best rider under 18

Exmoor Pony of the Year Qualifier

Will be awarded to the Champion Youngstock and Senior pony, also to the Champion Ridden pony

Rosette for the highest placed Exmoor Area Member

Points to be awarded to Exmoor Area Members, for their placing in each class. 1^{st} 6pts, 2^{nd} 5pts etc

<u>Rules</u>

All children under 14 years old must wear a correctly fitting, safety hat when leading ponies inside or outside of the ring.

All ponies are to be registered in section 1 of the EPS stud book

All Stallions and Colts over 2 years old must wear stallion or colt badges that are easily viewable. They must also be in possession of a stallion licence

Brood mares are to be 4 years and over

Foals at foot must be 3 weeks of age or older on the day of the show

No spurs are to be worn in any ridden classes

No schooling whips longer than 30" are to be used in the ring

No assistance from outside of the ring will be allowed

The judge's decision is final
