In order to comply with the Health & Safety of Dunster Country Fair the SWSPG has been asked for each Exhibitor to contribute the sum of £3.00 for First Aid. There will be 2 Ambulances on the field with 2 Paramedic Crews. Also 2 First Responders at the First Aid Post.

Rosettes 1st – 6th in all classes except classes 1 & 2, 4 & 5 where there is **Rosettes** to all.

SPS-BS Rosettes must only be given to ponies registered with the Society or to Foals eligible for registration.

SPS-BS BRONZE MEDALS – The Shetland Pony Stud-Book Society Bronze Medals will be awarded to the Champion Miniature, Champion Standard and the Ridden Champion. Pony subject to being registered with the SPS-BS and the owner/exhibitor is a fully paid up Member of the SPS-BS. In the event of the Champion pony or owner/exhibitor not being eligible, the Bronze Medal can be awarded to the Reserve Champion, should they meet the Registration and Membership requirements. Medals will be awarded by the Show Secretary, upon production of a current SPS-BS Membership Card.

Trythall Stud Trophy will be awarded to the Supreme Champion.

Winner **MUST** be a Member of the SWSPG. The Trophy is Perpetual and **MUST** be signed for.

1. Lead Rein Pony Mare or Gelding 4 years old & over. Rider must have attained their 3rd birthday by the day of their class and not to have attained their 9th birthday on the 1st January of year of Show. Ponies must be shown in a suitable snaffle bridle. The lead rein must be attached to the noseband only. **The reins must go directly from the bit to the rider's hands. The only attachment to the saddle allowed are a crupper or handle. Reins must not be attached to the handle or saddle. The reins must be an appropriate length and not knotted together or stitched together at a shorter length.**

SPS-BS Rosette to the winner of the class. **Rosettes** to all

2. First Ridden Pony Mare or Gelding, 4 years old & over. Rider must have attained their 3rd birthday by the day of their class and not to have attained their 12th birthday by the 1st January of the year of Show. **Ponies must be shown in any suitable snaffle bridle. Ponies must not be cantered except in their individual show.**

SPS-BS Rosette to the winner of the class. **Rosettes** to all

3. Open Ridden Pony Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old & over. Any rider of suitable height and weight. Rider any age except for Stallions where the rider must have attained their 12th birthday by the day of their class. **Any suitable bridle is permitted apart from bitless bridles & running gags.**

SPS-BS Rosette to the winner of the class.

4. Young Handler 3 – 8 years old. (Must be 3 years of age on the day of the Show)

SWSPG RULES

By entering the Show, you have agreed and accepted all these rules

- 1) The Organisers of the Shetland Pony Ring (Show) have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone **MUST** take care to prevent accidents occurring and **MUST** obey the instructions of the Officials and Stewards.
- 2) All Exhibitors are advised to have their own Public Liability Insurance.
- 3) All vehicles are parked at the risk of the Owners and the Organisers will not be liable for any damage whatsoever or how so ever caused.
- 4) First Aid is on site. Read all about First Aid on page 2 of this Schedule.
- 5) Objections which may only be lodged by the Owner or their authorised representative must be handed to the Secretary, in writing within 15 minutes of the incident and must be accompanied by £20 deposit. Returnable if the objection is upheld.
- 6) No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the correct entry fee.
- 7) The Organisers reserve the right to limit entries and refuse entry to any Exhibitor without giving a reason.
- 8) This Show is also run under the rules of the Shetland Pony Stud-Book Society (SPS-BS).
- 9) The Judge's decision is final.
- 10) All Ponies entered must be registered with the Shetland Pony Stud-Book Society. Ponies full name must be on the entry form.
- 11) SPS-BS Rosettes must only be given to ponies registered with the Society or to Foals eligible for registration.
- 12) 3 years old Fillies with Foals at foot may not be shown.
- 13) All Foals must be a minimum of 3 weeks old on the day of the Show.
- 14) All Stallions and Colts 2 years old and over must be suitably bitted. They are also advised to display a Colt/Stallion Bridle Badge.
- 15) IN ORDER TO ENTER A STALLION IN HAND OR A RIDDEN CLASS AT AN AFFILIATED SHOW, ENTIRE MALES AGED 4 YEARS OLD AND OVER **MUST** HAVE AN 'S' NUMBER AND HAVE BEEN SUCCESSFULLY THROUGH EITHER THE SPS-BS STALLION ASSESSMENT PRIOR TO 2006 OR THE CURRENT SPS-BS VOLUNTARY VETERINARY EXAMINATION.
In Hand Classes Stallion/Colts are advised to display a Bridle Badge. All Stallions in Ridden classes **MUST** wear a Bridle Badge.
- 16) Exhibitors should not kneel but remain standing while in the Ring.
- 17) There **MUST** be no Colts or Stallions in the Young Handler classes.
- 18) Children under 14 years old may not show Colts (excluding Foals) or Stallions in the In Hand classes.
- 19) Handlers of ponies in the In Hand classes aged 14 years old and under **MUST** wear correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats conforming to current British Safety Standards /Specifications.

- 20) Riders of all ages **MUST** wear correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats conforming to current British Safety Standards/Specifications.
- 21) Riders of Stallions **MUST** be 12 years old and over.
- 22) If a Rider falls off at any time whilst in the Ring, both pony and rider must leave the Ring. Rider dismounted and take no further part.
- 23) Whips or canes must not exceed 30"
- 24) Mobile phones are not permitted in the Ring under any circumstance.
- 25) All dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
- 26) For the safety of spectators, especially children, the Collecting Ring Area is for **EXHIBITORS ONLY**. Please adhere to this Rule.
