1. Lead Rein Pony Mare or Gelding 4 years old & over. Rider must be at least 3 years old but not to have attained their 9th birthday by the 1st January of the current year.

Snaffle bridle only and the lead rein to be attached to the noseband.

Rosettes to all. **SPSBS Rosette** to the winner of the class.

2. First Ridden Pony Mare or Gelding 4 years old & over. Rider not to have attained their 12th birthday by the 1st January of the current year. Shown in any suitable bridle.

Rosettes to all. **SPSBS Rosette** to the winner of the class.

Ridden Championship

1st & 2nd prizewinners from classes 1 & 2 to compete

3. Young Handler 11 years old & under. No Colts or Stallions. (Entry Fee £5.00)

Rosettes to all. **SPSBS Rosette** to the winner of the class.

4. Young Handler 12 - 16 years old. No Colts or Stallions (Entry Fee £5.00)

Rosettes to all. **SPSBS Rosette** to the winner of the class.

Young Handler Championship

All Colts 2 or 3 years old must be suitably bitted and it is recommended they display a Colt badge on their bridle.

All Stallions **MUST** have an 'S' number to be eligible for entry in classes 13 - 15. Please read Rule number 14 before entering. It is advised to display a Stallion Badge on their bridle.

SWSPG RULES

By entering the Show, you have agreed and accepted all these rules

- 1) The organisers of the Shetland Pony Show have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone **MUST** take care to prevent accidents occurring and **MUST** obey the instructions of the officials and stewards.
- 2) All Exhibitors are advised to have their own Public Liability Insurance.
- 3) First Aid is on site.
- 4) Objections which may only be lodged by the owner or their authorised representative must be handed to the Secretary, in writing within 15 minutes of the incident and must be accompanied by £20 deposit. Returnable if the objection is upheld.
- 5) No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the correct entry fee.
- 6) The organisers reserve the right to limit entries and refuse entry to any exhibitor without giving a reason.
- 7) This Show is also run under the rules of the Shetland Pony Stud Book Society (SPSBS).
- 8) The Judge's decision is final.
- 9) All Ponies entered must be registered with the Shetland Pony Stud Book Society. Ponies full name must be on the entry form.
- 10) SPSBS Rosettes must only be given to ponies registered with the Society or to foals eligible for registration.
- 11) 3 years old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown.
- 12) All foals must be a minimum of 3 weeks old on the day of the Show.
- 13) All Stallions and Colts 2 years old and over must be suitably bitted. They are also advised to display a Colt/Stallion Bridle Badge.
- 14) IN ORDER TO ENTER A STALLION IN HAND OR A RIDDEN CLASS AT AN AFFILIATED SHOW, ENTIRE MALES AGED 4 YEARS OLD AND OVER **MUST** HAVE AN 'S' NUMBER AND HAVE BEEN SUCCESSFULLY THROUGH EITHER THE SPSBS STALLION ASSESSMENT PRIOR TO 2006 OR THE CURRENT SPSBS VOLUNTARY VETERINARY EXAMINATION.
- 15) Exhibitor should not kneel but remain standing while in the Ring.
- 16) There must be no Colts or Stallions in the Young Handler classes.

- 17) Children under 14 years old may not show Colts (excluding foals) or Stallions in the In Hand classes.
- 18) Handlers of ponies in the In Hand classes aged 14 years old and under MUST wear correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the current Safety Standards/Specifications.
- 19) Riders of all ages MUST wear correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the current Safety Standards/Specifications.
- 20) If a Rider falls off at any time whilst in the Ring, both pony and rider must leave the Ring. Rider dismounted and take no further part.
- 21) Whips or canes must not exceed 30"
- 22) All dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
- 23) For the safety of spectators, especially children, the Collecting Ring Area is for Exhibitors ONLY. Please adhere to this Rule.
